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The information provided is to be used by The Old Foster Community Museum Scholarship Committee for the sole purpose of evaluating candidates for scholarships and making recommendations to the Board of Directors.

- 1. The candidate shall be a United States citizen and a resident of Fort Bend County. He/She shall be a High School Senior, graduating in May, 2019 at a LCISD high school campus and having been accepted for Fall attendance at a college in the state of Texas, which can be either a 4-year college (public or private) or a community college. The graduating senior must have at least a final GPA of 3.0.
- 2. The scholarship award is a fixed amount of \$1,000.00 determined by the Board of Directors and is to be applied to normal tuition and fees. Scholarship monies will be deposited by the Museum into his/her student account at his/her respective college.
- 3. The duration of the scholarship is for the scholastic year beginning no later than the fall semester following the award.
- 4. The candidates will be from each of the five area high schools, Foster, Fulshear, Lamar, Terry and George Ranch. The top twenty (20) applicants will be chosen based on an accumulation of grade point/school standing and SAT/ACT scores. These twenty (20) students will interview for the scholarship(s).
- 5. The Scholarship Committee will pick up from the School Counselor all applications which must include the following five items:
  - i. The application must be totally and accurately filled out.
  - ii. Provide proof of citizenship either copy of passport or birth certificate.
  - iii. Provide a copy of the acceptance letter from the accredited TEXAS college/university.
  - iv. Include "official" copy of applicant's transcript and SAT/ACT scores (must be provided by school in sealed envelope).
  - v. Submit a typed paper, 500-1,000 words on the subject relating to Ft. Bend/Texas history: either what this history has meant/means to the candidate *or* on a person who has had a significant impact on this area's history *or* on an event that has affected this area's history.
- 6. The deadline for the application, required documents, and essay submission is Friday, March 15, 2019 to the School Counselor. Failure to accurately complete the above five requirements will result in elimination for scholarship consideration.
- 7. The candidates, shall be available for an interview with the Scholarship Committee at the Museum located at 7720 FM 359, Richmond, Texas, 77406 the week of March 25, 2019, specific date TBA. Candidates will be notified regarding specific interview times. There will be no make-up days. The interview process is a requirement for scholarship consideration.
- 8. The candidates shall be notified of the Scholarship Committee's selection within a week following the interview. There will be one recipient from each campus.
- 9. The recipients will be guests and recognized at the annual fundraiser scheduled for April 4, at the Jones Creek Ranch Park, 7714 FM 359, Richmond, 77406. Parents of the recipients are also invited to attend as the Museum's guests. Additional family members attending will require a ticket.
- 10. The Scholarship Committee shall hold all information provided herein confidential.
- 11. The candidate specifically authorizes The Old Foster Community Museum of Fort Bend County Scholarship Committee to substantiate any data provided herein.
