You've completed your first semester this school year!


We're sure that you've had a lot of great new experiences alongside unexpected challenges. But now it's time for you to learn how you can be rewarded for everything you've accomplished.








Step 1: Entering in Grades

Click "Add course" on your Portfolio. Specify the course type, name, and then enter in your grades!

Do you get quarter, semester, or trimester grades? Be sure to choose the right default grading period!






After you enter in a grade, RaiseMe will tell you if a college has awarded you!

Step 2: Entering in Other Accomplishments

Did you play any sports this past year or participate in extracurricular activities? Add those into your portfolio!

Step 3: Entering in Test Scores


What does that bell do?



What else can I earn scholarships for?


Click on the scholarships tab to give you more ideas on what achievements colleges want to see you complete. Referring a friend will net you \$100 in micro-scholarships!





Visit a partner college's "Scholarships" tab!






Why aren't I earning anything towards X college?
