The information provided is to be used by Veterans of Foreign War Auxiliary Scholarship Committee for the sole purpose of evaluating candidates for scholarships.

- 1. The candidate shall be a United States citizen and a resident of Fort Bend County. He/She shall be a High School Senior, graduating in May, 2019 from a LCISD high school and having been accepted for Fall attendance at a college in the state of Texas, which can be either a 4-year college (public or private) or a community college. The graduating senior must have at least a final GPA of 3.0.
- 2. The scholarship award is a fixed amount of \$1,000.00 determined by the VFW Auxiliary and is to be applied to normal tuition and fees. Scholarship monies will be deposited by the VFW Auxiliary into his/her student account at his/her respective college.
- 3. The duration of the scholarship is for the scholastic year beginning no later than the fall semester following the award.
- 4. The candidates will be from each of the five area high schools, Foster, Fulshear, Lamar, Terry and George Ranch. The top twenty (20) applicants will be chosen based on an accumulation of grade point/school standing and SAT/ACT scores. These twenty (20) students will interview for the scholarship(s).
- 5. The Scholarship Committee will pick up from the School Counselor all applications which must include the following <u>five</u> items:
 - i. The application must be totally and accurately filled out.
 - ii. Provide proof of citizenship either copy of passport or birth certificate.
 - iii. Provide a copy of the acceptance letter from the accredited TEXAS college/university.
 - iv. Include "official" copy of applicant's transcript and SAT/ACT scores (must be provided by school in sealed envelope).
 - v. Submit a typed paper, 500-1,000 words on the subject "what constitutes your idea of an American military hero" and can be a specific person, past or present, or an idea/belief/feeling.
- 6. <u>The deadline for the application, required documents, and essay submission is Friday, May 17, 2019 to the School</u> <u>Counselor</u>. <u>Failure to accurately complete the above five requirements will result in elimination for scholarship</u> <u>consideration</u>.
- <u>The candidates, shall be available for an interview with the Scholarship Committee at the VFW Post 3903, 1903 1st Street (Hwy. 36), Rosenberg, TX 77471 the first part of June, specific date and time TBA. Candidates will be notified regarding specific interview times. There will be no make-up days. The interview process is a requirement for scholarship consideration.

- The candidates shall be notified of the Scholarship Committee's selection within two weeks following the interview. There will be one recipient from each campus. The recipients will be recognized at a special ceremony at the VFW Post 3903 on July 1st at 6:00 p.m.
- 9. The Scholarship Committee shall hold all information provided herein confidential.
- 10. The candidate specifically authorizes Ladies Auxiliary VFW Scholarship Committee to substantiate any data provided herein.
